Hosting a Diaper Drive



What is a Diaper Drive?

Host a drive to collect diapers; reach out to friends, family, neighbors, colleagues, etc. During your drive, collect as many diapers as possible while sharing about the diaper need in our community. Deliver donated products to JLA for the Diaper Bank team to package and distribute to a family in need.



Choose Your Location(s)

Pick a place that is centrally located. A library, school, or local business. Gain the support of the community by making it convenient to donate! Selecting a location that is easily accessible will generate greater participation. Label collection bins, and download our drop box flyer!



Decide on a Time Frame

Plan to host your diaper drive for at least a week or longer, so people have enough time to donate. Does it make sense to tie your drive to a holiday or community tradition? Perhaps you can partner with an already planned event! FYI: National Diaper Need Awareness Week takes place at the end of every September.



Get the Word Out

Announce your diaper drive through social media, press releases to local media and the posting of notices (like the fact sheets and flyers included) near the locations to donate! One of the best ways to advertise is word of mouth so be sure to talk about anyone and everyone.

Diaper Drive Ideas

Time to Team Up

Hosting a drive with a few friends, coworkers, or family members can really help spread the word and minimize the work load by sharing it among a few people. Grab a helpfulhand or two and get started!

Themes

Picking a theme can make your diaper drive stand out! Themes can be simple as "Moms helping Moms", Stuff a Bus, or more creative like a themed dinner dance for diapers!

Locations

Be creative & convenient. There are many ideal locations for a diaper drive. Some examples are:

- Schools
- Places of worship
- Community Centers
- Offices
- Libraries
- Coffee shops
- Car dealerships
- Gyms
- Grocery stores
- Fire stations
- · In lieu of gifts

Pick a Team

We are surrounded by potential teams! Some examples are:

- Community groups
- · Work team
- Sports team
- Book club
- Student Service Project
- Religious groups

Party It Up

If you're planning a party, ask guests to bring a pack of diapers as their admission or in lieu of gifts!

- Baby shower
- Block party
- Birthday party
- Cocktail party
- Game or movie night

Include this text on your shower invite: In lieu of gifts, we are accepting diaper donations for The Junior League of Albuquerque Diaper Bank. These diapers will help other babies and toddlers in our community.



Make it a Competition

Make your diaper drive fun and engaging! Have a competition and offer small prizes or recognition for the team, class or office that brings in the most diapers! Friendly competition can help spread the word and increase turnout.

Pass the Torch

Be sure to promote your results to all those who participated and others as well. Use terms like "this time we collected" or "this time we raised..." so people understand there is an ongoing need. Offer support to those who want to host a diaper drive of their own!



Social Media Tips



Get the Word Out

Social media is a highly effective tool to reach a large number of people in very little time. Take advantage of your online presence and notify as many people as possible to participate in your diaper drive. (Make sure your volunteers are doing the same!)

Facebook

- Create a Facebook "Event" and invite all your friends. This is a great way to keep track of interest and to post updates on your collection status. Be sure to share the event with NDBN and JLA Diaper Bank
- Share your story (create posts with all the diaper drive details or even record a Facebook Live)
- Create a sharable profile picture frame
- Thank donors by giving them a shout out and tagging them in your posts
- Upload plenty of photos and use the universal hashtag #EndDiaperNeed in your posts
- Tag and mention Junior League of Albuquerque, too

Instagram

- Share pictures of your diaper drive flyer, donations, EVERYTHING
- Utilize the location tagging tool to share your collection sites
- Tag JLA Diaper Bank @juniorleagueabq
- Use hashtags like #JLAbqDiaperBank #EndDiaperNeed and #DiaperOn

Twitter

- Tweet before, during, and after your fundraiser. Let your supporters know how planning is going, how close you are to your goal, and the results
- Share a link to your Facebook event, or fundraising page where followers can learn more about your diaper drive and diaper need
- Remember to include the hashtag #EndDiaperNeed and personal hashtags for your diaper bank

Get Personal: Send a text or email!

Texts and emails are incredibly effective tools to utilize throughout your diaper drive. Personalize your message and go into detail on why you are hosting a diaper drive and would like the individual or company to participate. Explain what you are collecting, where, and of course, your goal.

Diaper Drive Checklist

Partner with JLA Diaper Bank

First visit jlabq.org to find more information about our organization and apply to host a Diaper Drive. This is an important step to ensure you receive the resources you need and set up a drop off time.

Select Start and End Date

Decide when you want to start and stop collecting diapers. A good deadline helps everyone. Diaper Drives usually last a week or a month.

Set Your Goals

How many donations would you like to raise? After we get your application we will let you know what sizes have the highest need. Develop a way to track your progress or use our goal chart.

Recruit Volunteers

Ask friends, family, colleagues, or neighbors to help out!

Choose Your Locations

Decide where you will collect your donated product. Pick one or more locations that are centrally located and willing to help, like a local business, bank, library, etc. Be sure to label your collection bin (flyer included in this toolkit).

Spread the Word

Announce your diaper drive via social media, emails, local news outlets, and post a flyer in.a common area or send an invite to friends and family. Distribute the diaper need fact sheets in this toolkit. Be active before AND during the drive!

Start Collecting Diapers

Rally the volunteers and start collecting diapers! Don't forget to take photos you'll need them later!

Deliver the Diapers

Contact us at community@jlabq.org to coordinate a time to drop off all the diapers you collected. If you can bring a few people who participated to help unload! Please tally up the diapers or other products you collected on the tally sheet in this toolkit. This helps us with inventory and helps you determine if you achieved your goal.


Share Your Results



Fast Facts about... Junior League of Albuquerque Diaper Bank

What Is the Junior League of Albuquerque Diaper Bank?

The JLA Diaper Bank was founded in 2018 and is the only Diaper Bank serving the Albuquerque Metro area. Run by our volunteer members, the Diaper Bank collects, purchases, and packs diapers for our community partners across the Albuquerque Metro Area. Our partners place monthly orders and receive diapers at no cost, to distribute to their clients. Through these partnerships, we are able to distribute thousands of diapers annually.

We are proud members of the National Diaper Bank Network, a national organization of banks working to end period poverty in local communities.

Why Diapers?



Diapers are material basic necessities all children require, as essential as food, shelter, and clothing. Yet, most state and national safety-net programs do not recognize diapers as a basic need.

Fast Facts about... Diaper Need in the United States

What Is Diaper Need?

Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient amount of diapers to keep a baby clean, dry, and healthy.

This is an issue affecting 1 in 2 families in our community.

Babies require up to 12 diapers a day, toddlers about eight.

The Numbers

5M	Babies and toddlers live in poor or low-income families.
\$70-\$80	Average monthly cost of diapers per child.
0	Number of federal programs that cover the cost of diapers.

Diapers are material basic necessities all children require, as essential as food, shelter, and clothing. Yet, most state and national safety-net programs do not recognize diapers as a basic need.

The Consequences of Diaper Need

- Babies who remain too long in a soiled diaper are exposed to potential health risks
- Most child care centers, even free and subsidized facilities, require parents to provide a day's supply of disposable diapers
- Many parents cannot go to work or school if they can't leave their babies at child care



A recent study conducted by NDBN and Huggies found that parents who struggled with diaper need missed an average of four days of work a month.*
